It was John matching the first game win with some nice shots and position play in game 2. Ray turned in some key shots in game 3 to put the win on the scoresheet for him and John. Scott got a gift in game 4 as his opponents put the eight ball in the correct pocket, but also dropped the cue ball in a pocket for the loss. John and Ray followed that up with back-to-back wins in game 5 \& 6 to take the opening set 4-2. Unfortunately, Scott was being hounded by his work throughout the beginning of the match with some major issues that he had to deal with at the hospital where he works. After Scott took game one of the 9 Ball Set, he got called back to work and had to leave immediately. A decision was made to credit Scott with the same number of wins that he achieved in the first set for the final two sets of the match rather than a complete forfeit. This gave Scott S. (6) points and John and Ray (12) points. This was agreed upon by Scott, John, Ray and our other League Administrator Walter. 10 Ball Set was not played.

Karen stayed instrumental with her play placing some key safety shots to help her partner Eddie close out the first two games of the set. Things then suddenly went cold for Eddie and Karen. Dale playing with the bye seemed to get his game together starting in game 3 . He strung together a nice run to nail down that game. Missed shots and open tables seemed to favor Dale throughout the next several games. Dale seemed to get into a nice rhythm with the extra shots he had playing without a partner. He notched game 3 and with every miss by his opponents he strung together win after win. When it was over, he won the last four games in the set and took the lead in the match. Eddie \& Karen broke the winning streak of Dale as they opened the 9 Ball Set with a nice run by Eddie to take game one. Dale evened up the set taking game two with a couple of nice shots to get to the 9 ball and win the game. Eddie fought back with a short run and nailed a game winner to take game 3 . Karen got into the winning act as well with a nice shot to nail the 9 ball for a win taking game 4. Eddie finished up game 5 and he and Karen took a 4 to 1 lead in the set. Dale stopped the three-game run nailing a 9-ball winner in game 6 and after two sets, this match was all tied up heading into the 10 Ball Set.
